

Neuroscience PhD Meeting

Neuroscience PhD students will be the protagonists of the day entitled “New Perspectives of Neuroscience” dedicated to PhD students who will foster research topics related to Neuroscience.

On **Friday 13 March 2020** in the Aula Magna of the University Congress Center in via Partenope 36, Naples, Italy, young Italian researchers will take stock of research activities carried out in the field of neuroscience.

A day to promote interaction, and exchange of ideas among young neuroscientists involved in scientific issues of great impact.

The Italian Neurosciences play an important role in the international scientific research scene both for studies on pathologies of the peripheral Nervous System and for those on neurodegenerative diseases such as Multiple Sclerosis, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis, cerebral ischemia, Parkinson's disease and Alzheimer's disease. A significant contribution to the success of Neuroscience in the European context is certainly provided by the research of young Italian scientists who have achieved results of international relevance in the field of neuroscience.

Over a hundred and fifty researchers will be guests of the University of Naples. Beginning at 8.30, the conference will be divided in eighteen oral Communications presented by young neuroscientists and in a Plenary Reading held by **Prof. Giacomo Rizzolatti**, University of Parma, the coordinator of the research team that discovered mirror neurons.

The conference also aims to stimulate the interaction between young researchers and expert researchers in order to allow the exchange of ideas on research issues of great scientific and social impact in the various sectors of neuroscience.

Particular attention will also be paid to the Poster session in order to further promote scientific interaction and to enable young neuroscientists to receive useful suggestions for the progress of their research.

The conference is organized by the Division of Pharmacology of the Department of Neuroscience of the School of Medicine and Surgery of the Federico University under the aegis of the Italian Society of Neuroscience.
